Key Responsibilities

- Provide prenatal, antenatal, and postnatal care to pregnant women, including health screenings, risk assessments, and labor and delivery support.
- Offer guidance on family planning, breastfeeding, nutrition, and newborn care.
- Conduct educational sessions for pregnant women and their families on maternal health, safe childbirth practices, and newborn care.
- Support and counsel women during pregnancy, childbirth, and the postpartum period, addressing their concerns and promoting mental well-being.
- Participate in community outreach efforts to raise awareness about the importance of maternal health services.
- Work closely with community health workers to identify pregnant women in need of care and encourage them to utilize MH-MH services.
- Assist in training traditional birth attendants to enhance local childbirth services and carry out other tasks as assigned.
